Fêting the Finns

1918-2018 – a hundred years of intrepid independence! Along with Iceland, Finland prefers to be classified as a Nordic country rather than as part of Scandinavia.

News from the Committee - AGM 27th March 2023

The AGM was well attended, thank you to all who came.

Reports were received from the Chair (Janice Haines) and Treasurer (Grace Wilkins). It was good to hear from the Chair that membership numbers are recovering after the setback of the Covid pandemic. The number of new members who have joined in the first three months of 2023 could make it a bumper year.

The Treasurer accompanied her report with a pie chart, which illustrated clearly the way that our yearly subscription is divided. There were a number of questions about the expenditure which kept Grace on her toes.

Before the election of Officers and Committee members, the Chair explained that at present the Vice Chair holds an Officer role on the committee. This causes difficulty if a Vice Chair is to take over as Chair, as under the Ludlow u3a Constitution, an Officer cannot move immediately from one officer role to another. She asked for a vote on the motion that the Vice Chair ceases to be an Officer role to overcome this difficulty. This motion was carried unanimously.

Barbara Ball has completed three years as Secretary of u3a in Ludlow, the maximum allowed under our constitution in that role. The meeting agreed unanimously that Sue Curthoys take on the role of Secretary, with Janice Haines and Grace Wilkins carrying on for a further year as Chair and Treasurer, respectively.

The election of committee members was also taken 'en bloc'. Four members of the previous committee; Barbara Ball, Michael Cooke, Sue Billing and Peter Law agreed to stand again, and two new members; Cath Beardes and Deborah Tillsley, joined the committee for the first time. *Please find Committee contact details at the end of the newsletter.*

During her report, the Treasurer pointed out that we no longer have an examiner for the yearly accounts. Though it is not a requirement that the accounts are examined, the Treasurer asked if a Ludlow u3a member would be willing to take on the task. After the meeting Ian Crosskell came forward and said that he would be willing to act as examiner for the accounts in 2023. The committee is very grateful to him.
